

**Directions to the Washington, D.C. Operations Office

Via Metro

Take the Orange or Blue lines to the Rosslyn Metro stop. The Rosslyn Metro stop is between Ft. Myer Drive and North Moore Street. After exiting the Metro train, take the escalator to the top and go through the Metro ticket check. Then stay left to exit towards N. Moore Street. At N. Moore Street turn right and head towards Wilson Blvd. The Boeing office building is straight ahead at 1200 Wilson Blvd.

Virginia

From National Airport (approximately 4 miles)

Exit National Airport onto the George Washington Memorial Parkway (GWP) going north. Follow the GWP to 395 south. Take 395 south to Route 110 toward Rosslyn. Once on Route 110, it is approximately 2 miles to Rosslyn (on the way you will pass the Pentagon which will be on the left). Upon entering Rosslyn, Route 110 becomes Wilson Blvd. After you go through the light at N. Lynn Street, the Boeing office building will be on the left at 1200 Wilson Blvd.

From the Pentagon, Crystal City or Pentagon City

Take Route 110 north towards Rosslyn and follow the directions above.

From Dulles International Airport (approximately 26 miles)

Take the Dulles Access Road (the only road from the airport) to Route 66 east. Follow Route 66 east to Exit 73 for Rosslyn/Key Bridge. After exiting, merge to the right onto Lee Highway (Route 29). Get into the far right lane and at the 2nd light make a right onto Ft. Myer Drive. Once on Ft. Myer Drive, get into the far left lane in order to go up the ramp (**do not** go through the overpass). At the next light, turn left onto Wilson Blvd. The Boeing office building is immediately on the right at 1200 Wilson.

From Tysons Corner Via 495 Beltway

From 495 take Route 66 east (HOV-2 restrictions 6:30 a.m.-9:00 a.m.) and follow the directions above.

From Springfield Via 495 or 95

At Springfield, Virginia, take 395 north toward Washington, D.C. Take Exit 8B (Rosslyn, Memorial Bridge). After you exit, you will be on Rt. 27, passing the Pentagon on the right. Take the first exit past the Pentagon marked, "Pentagon North Parking Entrance/110." As you exit, stay right and follow the sign for Rt. 110. Rt. 110 takes you into Rosslyn where it becomes Wilson Blvd. After you go through the light at Lynn Street, the Boeing office building will be on the left at 1200 Wilson, across from Orleans House restaurant.

Another Option, but more confusing:

At Springfield, Virginia, take 395 north toward Washington, D.C. Follow the signs that exit to Rosslyn (the signs will also include varying destinations, e.g. Arlington Cemetery, Pentagon, Washington Blvd, etc. at different times—but just look for Rosslyn). After taking the Rosslyn exit you will pass the Pentagon (on your right). After you pass the Pentagon and come near Memorial Bridge, you will see a sign that says "Rosslyn, Key Bridge next right." Take that right and go under the bridge. Then follow the signs that say to 50 West (**do not** take the sign marked 395). This merges into one lane for a short distance, then that one lane merges with two other lanes coming in from the right. At this point, get in the far right lane. Shortly you will see an overhead sign that says Rosslyn/Key Bridge. At that sign, turn right, but then

immediately work your way into the far left lane. Stay in the far left lane and you will see a sign that says “Left Turn Lane for Wilson Blvd Westbound.” Follow the lane that is left of that sign. At the light turn left onto Wilson Blvd. The Boeing office building is the first building on the left after you turn.

Via Route 50 East

Traveling on 50 east towards Washington, D.C., you will pass Ft. Myer on your right. Shortly after that you will be near the Rosslyn area. Take the right exit marked “Rosslyn, Key Bridge.” After circling around make a right onto N. Lynn Street, then immediately work your way into the left through lane. Go through the light at Fairfax Drive and move to the far left lane. Stay in the far left lane and you will see a sign that says “Left Turn Lane for Wilson Blvd Westbound.” Follow the lane that is left of that sign. At the light turn left onto Wilson Blvd. The Boeing office building is the first building on the left after you turn.

Maryland and Washington, D.C.

From the Capital Beltway (495)

After crossing the American Legion Bridge into Virginia, stay in the far right lane and take Exit 43 south onto the George Washington Parkway (GWP) towards Washington, D.C. Follow the GWP for approximately 8 miles, then take the exit that says “Roosevelt Bridge, Washington, D.C., Rosslyn” (this is a restricted exit from 7:00-9:00 a.m.). After exiting, follow the sign that says 50WRosslyn. Stay in the right lane. You will see an overhead sign that says Rosslyn/Key Bridge. At that sign turn right, but then **immediately** work your way into the far left lane. Stay in the far left lane and you will see a sign that says “Left Turn Lane for Wilson Blvd Westbound.” Follow the lane that is left of that sign. At the light turn left onto Wilson Blvd. The Boeing office building is the first building on the left after you turn.

From Baltimore Washington International (BWI) Airport

Take the BWI Parkway (295 south). Take the Route 50 (New York Avenue) exit headed toward Washington, D.C. From New York Avenue take 395 south to Route 110. Stay on Route 110 (past the Pentagon on your left) into Rosslyn where Route 110 becomes Wilson Blvd. Go through the light at Lynn Street and the Boeing office building is the first building on your left (across from the Orleans House restaurant).

From Washington, D.C. using the Roosevelt Bridge (1-66 west)

Follow the signs for 50W-Rosslyn. Move into the right lane. You will see an overhead sign that says Rosslyn/Key Bridge. At that sign turn right, but then **immediately** work your way into the far left lane. Stay in the far left lane and you will see a sign that says “Left Turn Lane for Wilson Blvd Westbound.” Follow the lane that is left of that sign. At the light turn left onto Wilson Blvd. The Boeing office building is the first building on the left after you turn.

From Washington, D.C. using Key Bridge in Georgetown

Cross the Key Bridge into Virginia and you will be on Ft. Myer Drive. (After crossing the Key Bridge you will see the Key Bridge Marriott Hotel on your right.) Stay on Ft. Myer Drive, but get in the far left lane. Go through the light at the intersection of N.19th St. & Key Boulevard, but stay in the far left (**do not** go through the underpass). At the next light turn left onto Wilson Blvd. After turning left, the Boeing office is the first building on the right.

Garage Entry (for Employees Only)

Via Wilson Boulevard (Two-way traffic)

When you get to Wilson Blvd going west, stay in the left lane. Just past the Boeing office building (1200 Wilson Blvd.) turn left at the traffic light onto Ft. Myer Drive (left of the overpass). Stay left and you will circle around via Fairfax Dr. to Lynn Street. Stay in the far left lane. The garage

entrance will be on your left just before the traffic light at Wilson Blvd. Above the garage entrance is a sign that says 1200 Wilson Blvd. During business hours a guard will be on duty at the garage entrance.

Via Ft. Myer Drive (One-way traffic – going south)

Once on Ft. Myer Drive (one way street) in Rosslyn, go through the underpass. At the end of the underpass, immediately get into the far left lane. This lane will circle you around via Fairfax Dr. to Lynn St. On Lynn Street stay in the far left lane. The garage entrance will be on your left just before the traffic light at Wilson Blvd. Above the garage entrance is a sign that says 1200 Wilson Blvd. During business hours a guard will be on duty at the garage entrance.

Via Lynn Street (One-way traffic – going north)

As you near Rosslyn via Lynn Street, get in the left lane. Go through the light at Fairfax Drive and move to and stay in the far left lane. The garage entrance will be on your left just before the traffic light at Wilson Blvd. Above the garage entrance is a sign that says 1200 Wilson Blvd. During business hours a guard will be on duty at the garage entrance.
